Tyrannosaurus Rex lived in the late Cretaceous Period, around 66 million years ago.

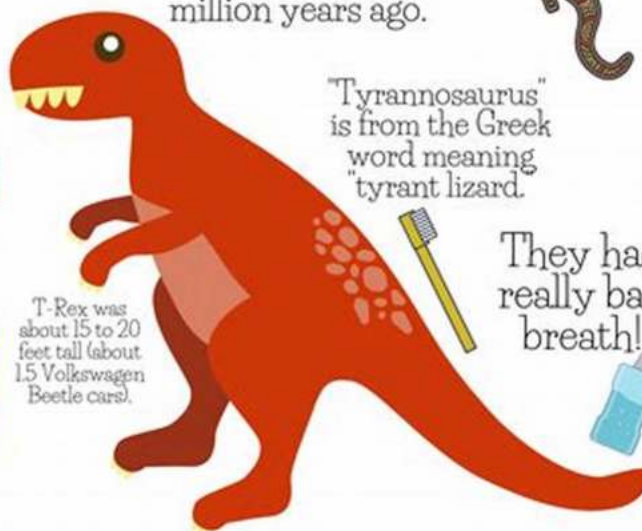


"Tyrannosaurus" is from the Greek word meaning "tyrant lizard."
