

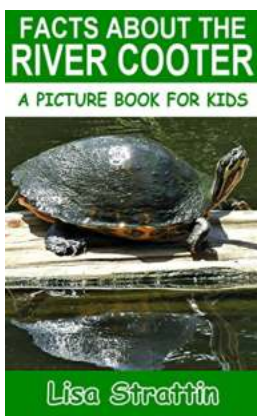

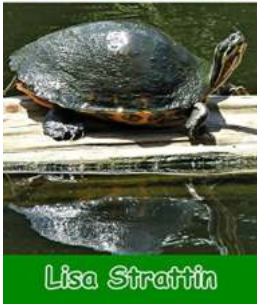
6. Conservation Status

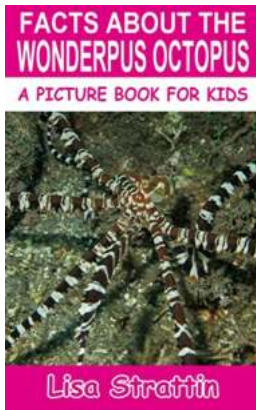

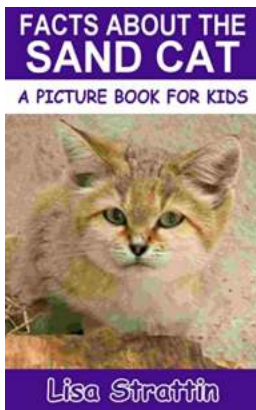
