

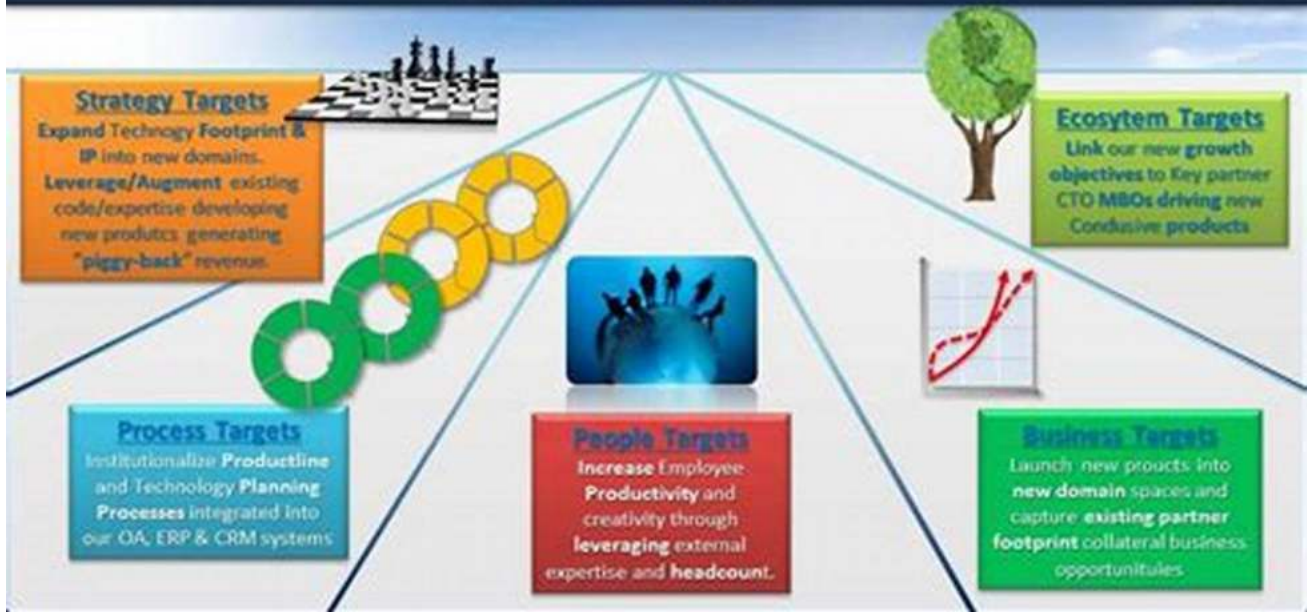

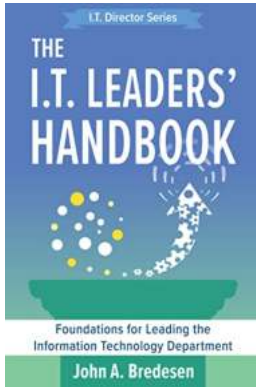
COMMUNICATION IMPROVEMENT STRATEGIES
