

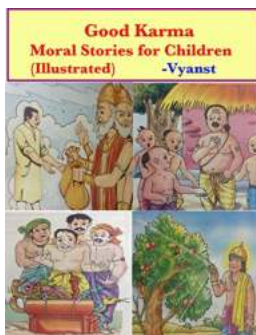

Teaching lessons through interactive discussions

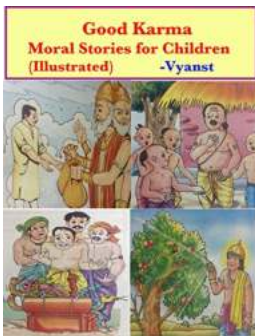
