

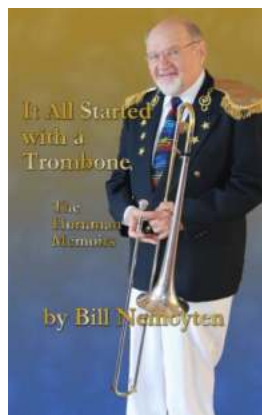

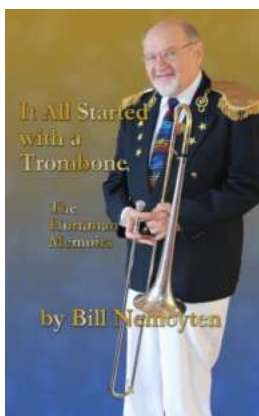

The book is enhanced by more than one hundred photographs, newspaper clippings and other memorabilia from Bill’s family, friends and former students.

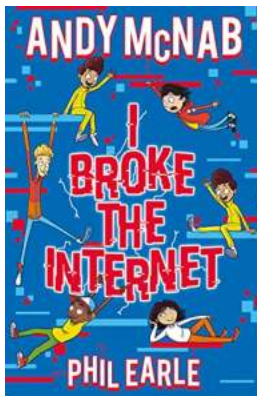
