breaking out of our current stalemate and proposes a strategy to create a new narrative in which change becomes possible.



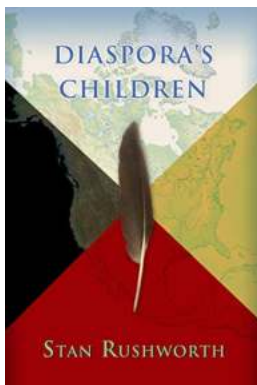

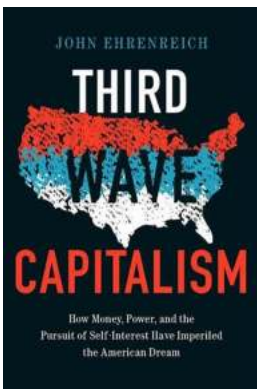

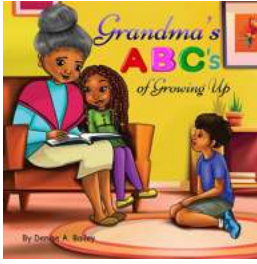
