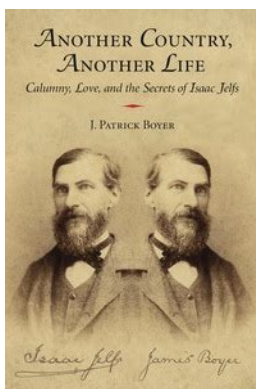


This is a historical memoir of a father's coming to America, and a son's return to his African roots.
