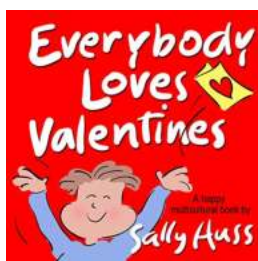
Jane appealed to their kindness, hoping that there might be anyone who would take her in... someone who would not consider her plainness a sin.
