

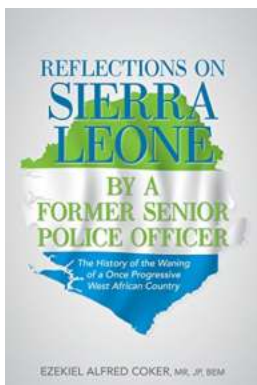

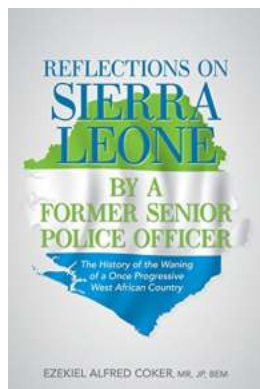

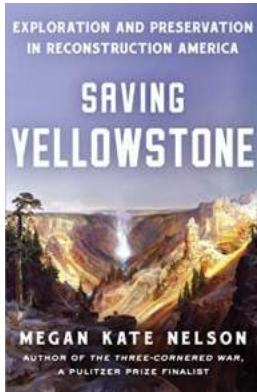


Sierra Leone is historically unique. A small part of the territory which was mainly Freetown (which was to become the capital of the whole country) and
