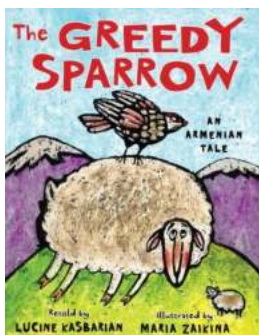


The Greedy Sparrow: An Armenian Tale That Teaches Us the True Meaning of Happiness
