success, Heard tells what it was like working in the Presidency. He looks to a better future under Cyril Ramaphosa, after the wreckage left behind by President Jacob Zuma.



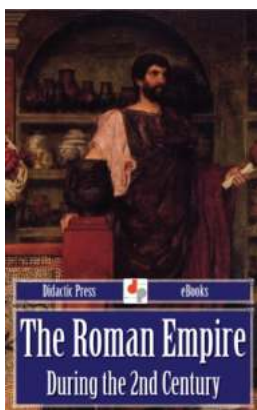
