





Life Between the Levees is a chronicle of first-person reflections and folklore from pilots who have dedicated their lives to the river. Among many topics, the pilots reflect movingly on the time spent away from home because of their career, a universal reality for all mariners. As many pilots say when they talk about the river, "I hate her when I'm with her, and I miss her when I'm gone."








