

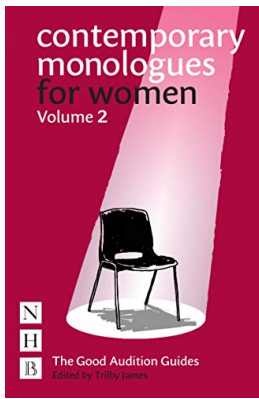

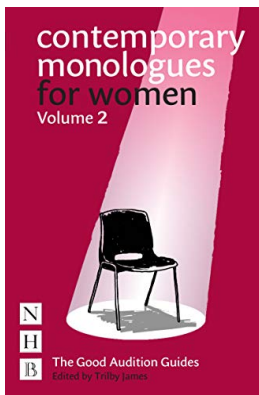

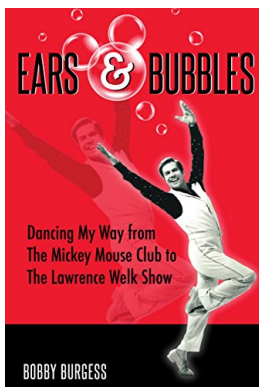

This book also features a step-by-step guide to the process of selecting and preparing your speech, and approaching the audition itself.

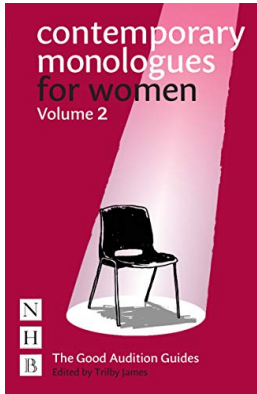
