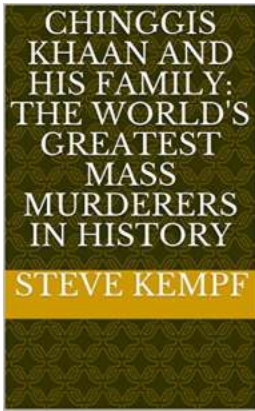

2. Joseph Stalin - The Soviet Union's Ruthless Leader



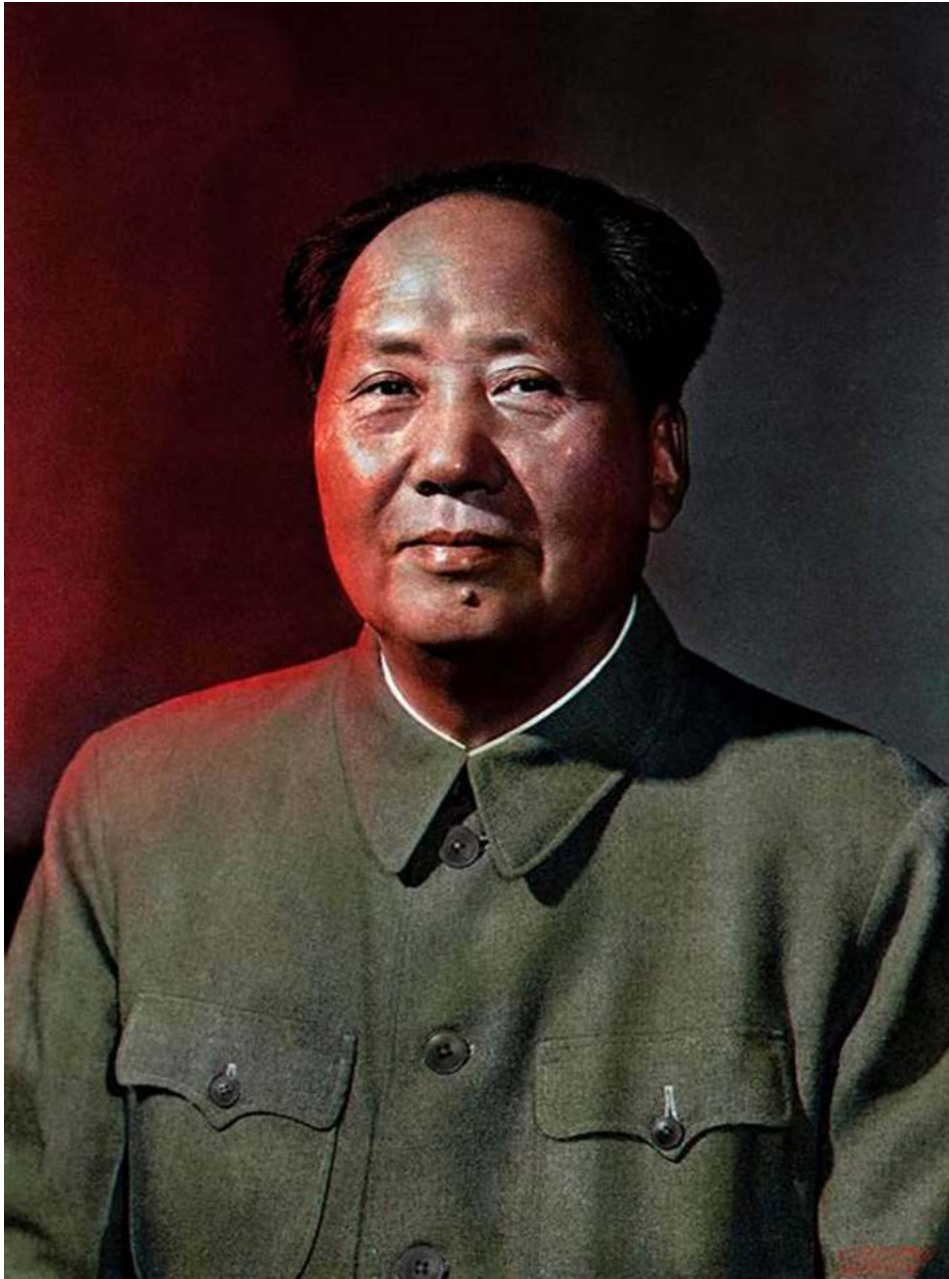
