




3. Cute Black Cats

Draw a curvy body underneath the head, and four long, slender legs extending from it. Don't forget to add curved lines to illustrate the cat's tail.




4. Creepy Ghosts

Ghosts are a Halloween staple, and capturing their eerie essence is quite easy. Begin by drawing the outline of a cloud-like shape for the ghost's body.


Next, give your ghost two oval-shaped eyes and a wide-open mouth in a screaming position. Add some extra, uneven lines to create a tattered and spooky effect.
