

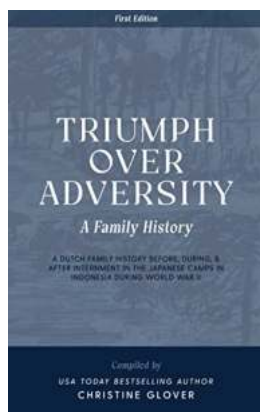

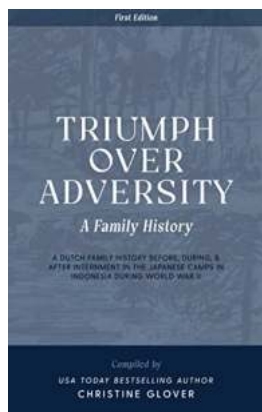

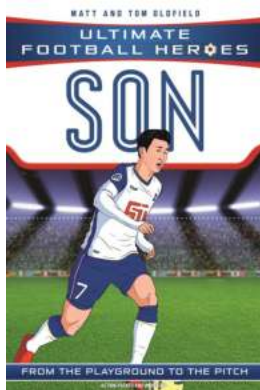
Evil does exist, but the spirit of survival and striving to overcome evil in every possible way to go on to live full, rich lives is stronger.

about the atrocities they faced during their years of incarceration has been overlooked by historians.

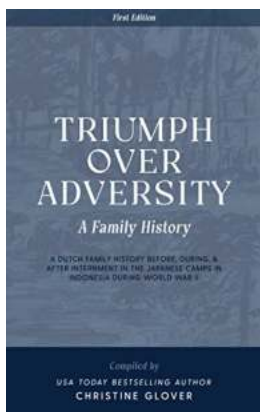
This book reveals their stories. And this book reveals how their incredible spirits and resilience and strength overcame the worst of adversities. They triumphed during a time of great upheaval.
