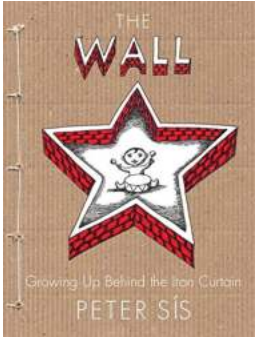

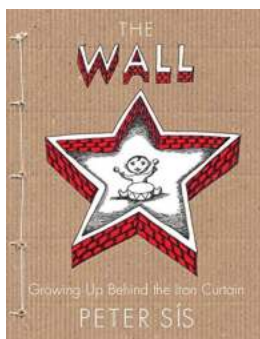

"I was born at the beginning of it all, on the Red side—the Communist side—of the Iron Curtain."
