

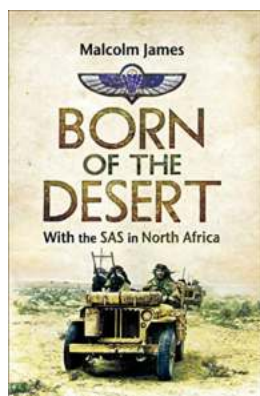

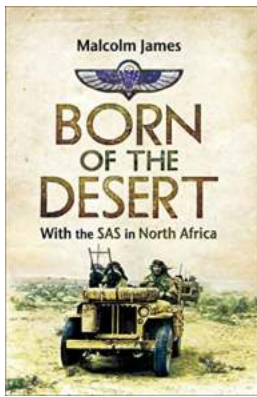

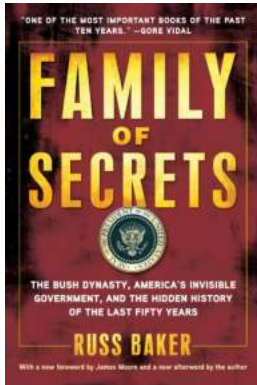


Born of the Desert is a classic account of the early years of the SAS. 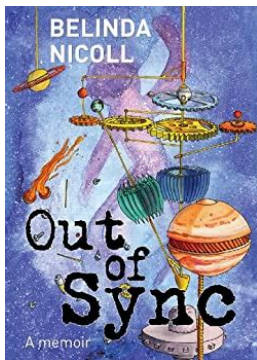
Born of the Desert was written soon after the events depicted and has an immediacy which places it above other Second World War memoirs. The original
