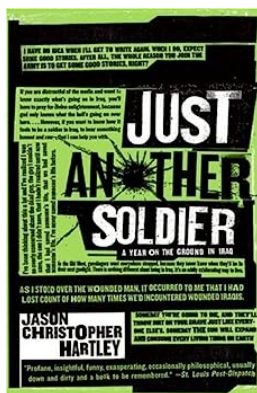

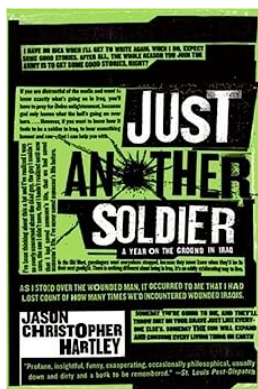

This is not your father's war

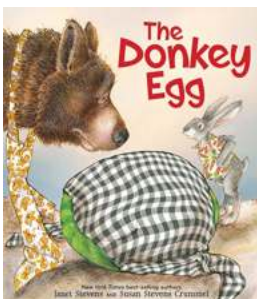
